1) Louis Aggasiz 18807-1873 (Founder of glacial science. He was a Creationist)
2) Charles Babbage 1791-1871 (Creator of Computer. He was a defender of the Bible, known as an 'apologist')
3) Johannes Kepler 1571-1630 (Laws of Planetary Motion. He believed the Bible literally)
4) Blaise Pascal 1623-1662 (Probability Studies. He was a Christian writer who wrote about the Bible)
5) John Ambrose Fleming 1849-1945 (Diode. Modern Electronics)
6) Issac Newton 1642-1726 (Universal Laws of Gravitation)
7) Georges Cuvier 1769-1832 (Comparative Anatomy. Creationist)
8) William Kelvin 1824-1907 (Thermodynamics. Creationist)
9) Carolus Linnaeus 1707-1778 (Modern taxonomy. Creationist)
