"Jesus: God's Son, Man of History: Part 1"

OBJECTIVE: In the context of 'knowing why' we should be asking why do we submit our lives to Jesus and if we do what does that look like? And why would we do that?

### SOMEBODY READ THIS FOR US:

Jesus made some pretty radical claims about Himself. We'll begin by looking at the claim that Jesus makes on our lives. He is God, as we'll see next week, and has the right to make these claims on our lives.

I) DEFINTION OF	

2 Corinthians 5:14, 15

### **2 Corinthians 5:14-15**

- <sup>14</sup> For Christ's love compels us, because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died. <sup>15</sup> And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again.
- the Lordship of Jesus Christ is the <u>daily submission</u> and <u>surrender</u> of our <u>entire self</u> to the authority and leadership of Jesus, recognizing His sovereign right to rule over us. (Colossians 1:18).

### Colossians 1:18

<sup>18</sup> And he is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy.

### (II) WHAT IS CHRIST'S \_\_\_\_\_ FOR HIS DISCIPLES?

(A) Luke 9:23 states the heart of discipleship.

### **Luke 9:23**

<sup>23</sup> Then he said to them all: "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me.

- (B) Deny yourself Putting the Lord and others first; refusing to live my life to please myself.
- (C) Take up your cross daily Submitting our will to the will of God. Luke 22:42.

### Luke 22:42

- <sup>42</sup> "Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done."
- (D) \_\_\_\_\_\_ Following Jesus and no one or nothing else. Matthew 4:19; 1 Peter 2:21.

### **Matthew 4:19**

19 "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will make you fishers of men."

### 1 Peter 2:21

- <sup>21</sup> To this you were called, because Christ suffered for you, leaving you an example, that you should follow in his steps.
- (E) The whole principle of Lordship is the removal of self <u>off of the throne</u> of one's life, and the invitation to Jesus to sit on the throne and rule, trusting Him to do what is best for us.
- (F) The battle of submission: two reasons why people do not acknowledge Jesus Christ as Lord of their life.
  - (1) They are \_\_\_\_\_ God may ask us to do something we don't want to do.
  - (2) They are that God has our best interest at heart. Jeremiah 29:11.

### Jeremiah 29:11

<sup>11</sup> For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

### (III) HOW DO I KNOW IF JESUS IS \_\_\_\_\_

(A) We show our love for Jesus by obeying His commands. John 14:15, 21, 23.

### John 14:15

<sup>15</sup> "If you love me, you will obey what I command.

### John 14:21

Whoever has my commands and obeys them, he is the one who loves me. He who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love him and show myself to him."

### John 14:23

- <sup>23</sup> Jesus replied, "If anyone loves me, he will obey my teaching. My Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him.
- (B) We must read the Word of God, see what God's will is for our lives and then we must do it. James 1:22-25.

# SOMEBODY READ THESE SCRIPTURES FOR US James 1:22-25

<sup>22</sup> Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.

Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like a man who looks at his face in a mirror <sup>24</sup> and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like. <sup>25</sup> But the man who looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues to do this, not forgetting what he has heard, but doing it--he will be blessed in what he does.

**LUKE 6:46-49** <sup>46</sup> "Why do you call me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say? <sup>47</sup> I will show you what he is like who comes to me and hears my words and puts them into practice. <sup>48</sup> He is like a man building a house, who dug down deep and laid the foundation on rock. When a flood came, the torrent struck that house but could not shake it, because it was well built. <sup>49</sup> But the one who hears my words and does not put them into practice is like a man who built a house on the ground without a foundation. The moment the torrent struck that house, it collapsed and its destruction was complete."
